

# Crandall High School Drumline 2008

## Required Materials for Every Rehearsal

### Everyone:

- At least a 1", 3-ring binder for all your music/drill charts
- 50 page protectors in the binder
- A pencil with an eraser
- Practice Pad
- Sunglasses
- A pair of earplugs while playing indoors
- White plastic tape for sticks and music (battery only)
- Black Wristbands for shows (full drumline)
- Low-top tennis shoes for marching (preferably white). **No sandals or boots**
- Shorts, flannel pants, or sweat pants allowed. **No jeans or tight-fitting pants**
- At least a ½ gallon jug full of water
- Sunscreen
- **A strong work ethic and a good attitude**

### Front Ensemble:

- Every player must provide own mallets
- Timpani (IP FS-T3), Keyboards (2 pairs of *Innovative Percussion 1003* marimba mallets)
- 1 pair of *Innovative Percussion IP-1M* General concert sticks w/felt ball

### Snares:

- 2 pairs of *Innovative Percussion Paul Rennick (FS-PR)* signature marching sticks

### Quads:

- 2 pairs of *Innovative Percussion TS-1*

### Basses:

- A highlighting marker for your individual split parts
- *Innovative Percussion* marching bass drum mallets
  - Bass #1 – FBX-1
  - Bass #2 – FBX-1
  - Bass #3 – FBX-2
  - Bass #4 – FBX-3
  - Bass #5 – FBX-4

### Cymbals:

- Tube of Zildjian Cymbal cream
- 2 pairs of Zildjian Cymbal straps

**Everyone must own a quality practice pad (HeavyHitter, Realfeel). Any one of these pads will do. If you own something other than this...GET RID OF IT AND GO BUY A GOOD PAD!**

**All percussionists should own a mallet/stick bag of some sort to hold all sticks and mallets. Follow the "6-12 Stick/Mallet Progression" to increase your collection for any circumstance. A perfect choice for a mallet bag is the *Innovative Percussion MB-1, MB-2, or MB-3.***

**Do you have a quality metronome? Be sure that the metronome has a headphone input. If it does not, then it is time to upgrade to the better model metronome. Either a *Dr. Beat DB-88* or a *Tama Rhythm Watch* will work with any headphone model.**
